These participants will spend six months in treatment and then three months at our sober living facility, at Grace Home. Once these nine months are completed the AGC Liberia team will assist them to reunite and reintegrate with their respective families. All of these men and women self-identified as wanting to go to treatment, by attending the selection day at St. Gabriel's Catholic Church in Brewerville, where they were interviewed by our AGC Liberia team. "This is a massive step forward in their journey to recovery and their dignity being restored," shared Henry Darbee Blamah, AGC Program Director.
