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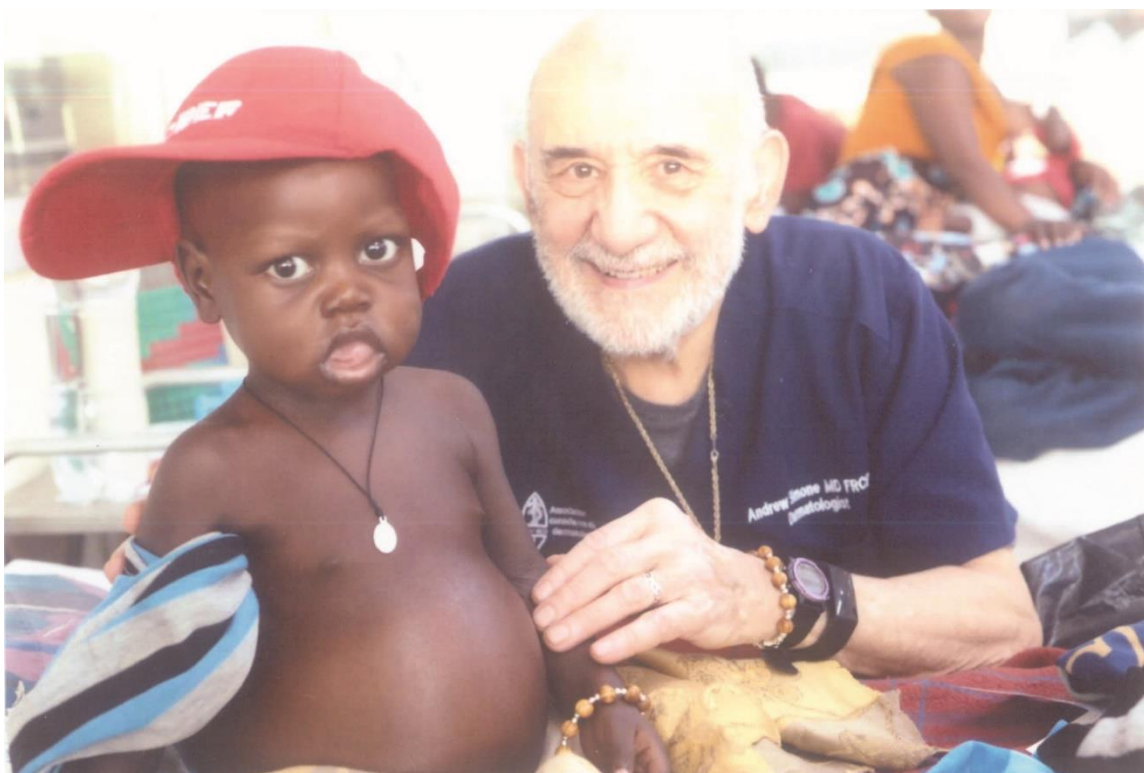
IVAN's Story – Kidney Cancer

RYAN's Story

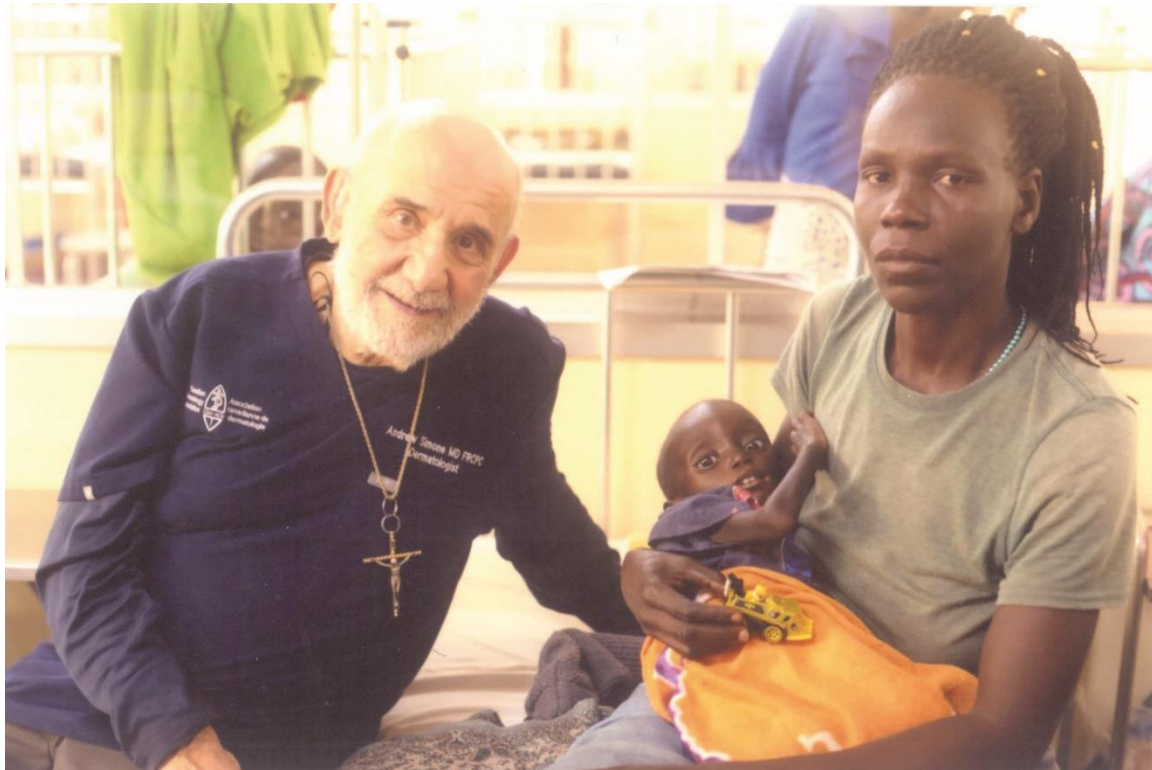

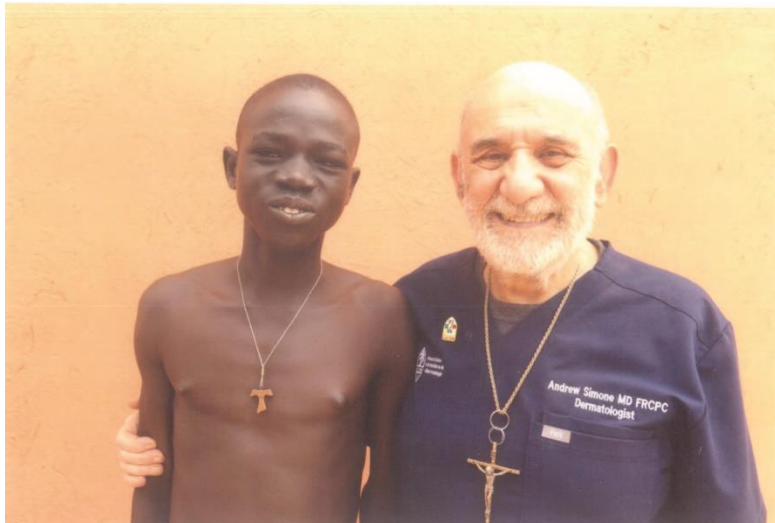

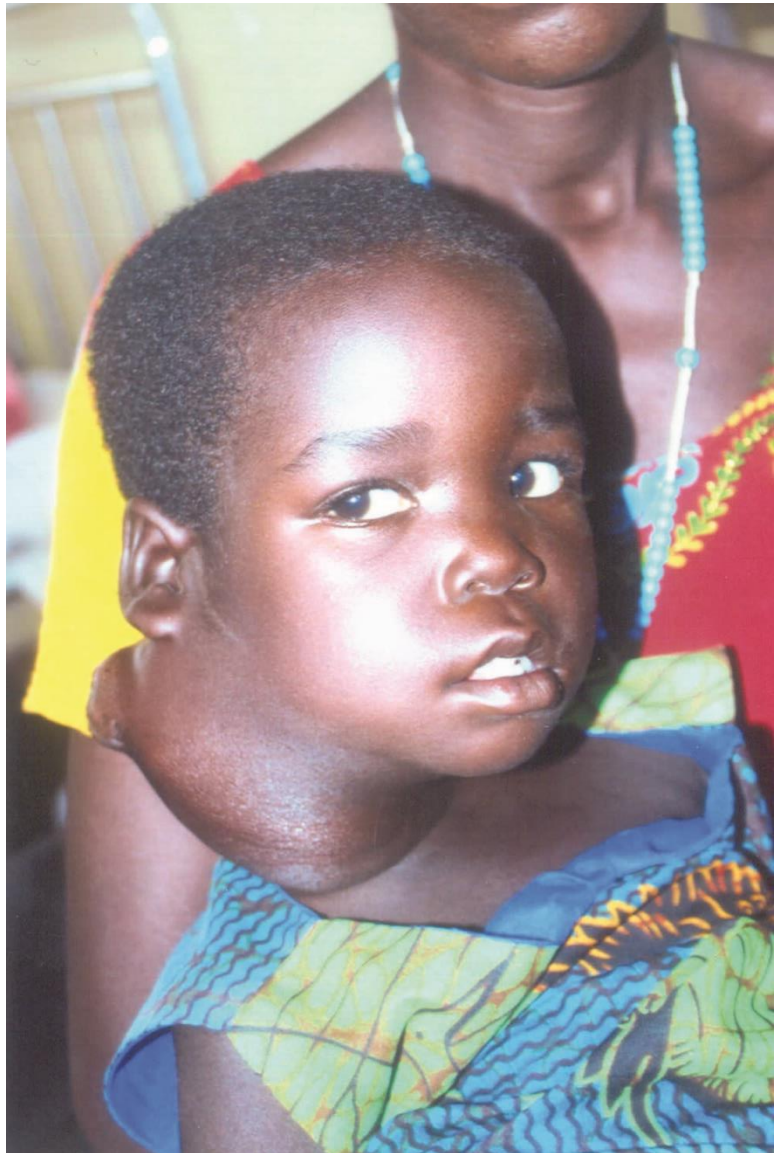
Julis - Osteogenic Sarcoma
